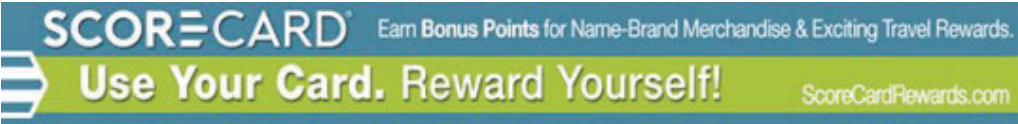
Little Engineer Club!

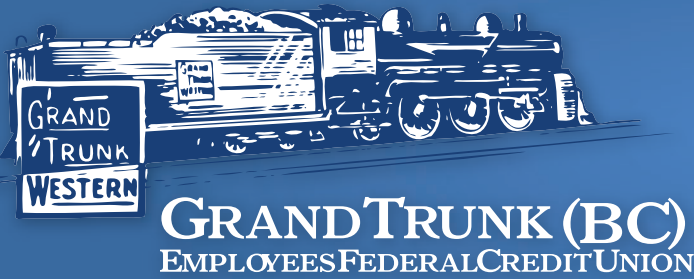





